(h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.

(i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.

The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if is so desires.

(k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

- AND WHEREAS, the institution Trisha College of Education Education, Thain Rangas, 463, Nadaun, Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh - 177001, Haimachal Pradesh was recognized by NRC vide its Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/HP-247/2008/39971-977 dated 20.02.2008 for B.Ed. course for 200 seats.
