1. One day workshop on first Aid:-

In the 56thIQAC Meeting. It was resolved that the health department will conduct a one day work shop on First-Aid.

Action taken and Compliance:-

On 3rd March 2025,

Trisha College of Education organized a One-day First Aid Camp under the guidance of College Chairman Sh. N.K.Sharma in Collaboration with BMO Nadaun Dr. Kamal Kishore Sharma. The objective of the camp was to equip students with essential life-saving skills to provide emergency care and assistance. The Program featured Dr. Kamal Kishore Sharma as the Chief Guest , While Community Health Offices Mrs Aarti Kapoor and Mrs Diksha Sharma Served a resource persons. During this camp students received hands on training on critical first aid skills including.

- ➤ CPR {Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation}
- ➤ Burn Treatment and Management
- ➤ Use of Medical Kits and equipment
- ➤ Others essential life-Saving techniques.

These Skills enable individuals to provide crucial care and assistance before medical help arrives potentially saving lives. College Chairman Sh.
