### **Agenda Points are:-**

#### **1. Educational Tour:-**

### **Action taken and Compliance:-**

**Action taken and Compliance:-**

Swami Vivekananda's Jayanti was celebrated with great enthusiasm in the college campus on 12<sup>th</sup> January. On the Occasion, the "Mera Yuva Bharat" department organized a program in collaboration with Trisha College. The event was graced by Ms. Deepa Mala, Distt Youth Officer, as the Chief Guest.

A guest lecture on "History of Education in India" was organised on 23<sup>rd</sup> January with N.K. Sharma Chairman as the resource person. He delivered a comprehensive speech covering the Vedic period to modern times, explaining the purpose of education in the Vedic period, focusing on character building and social responsibility. He discussed the Gurukul tradition, the development of education during the Mauryan and Gupta periods and India's Contribution to knowledge and science. He also highlighted the changes in the education system during the British era and post- independence, sharing information on key commissions, including the University Education Commission [1948], Secondary Education Commission [1952] and Kothari Commission [1964-66]. Students actively participated in the Q&A session, gaining a deeper understanding of the history of

education in India. The lecture provided valuable insights into the evolution of the education system and students appreciated the resource person's expertise and clarity of presentation.

#### **Action taken and Compliance:-**
